Granzyme B Is Critical for T Cell Receptor-Induced Cell Death of Type 2 Helper T Cells

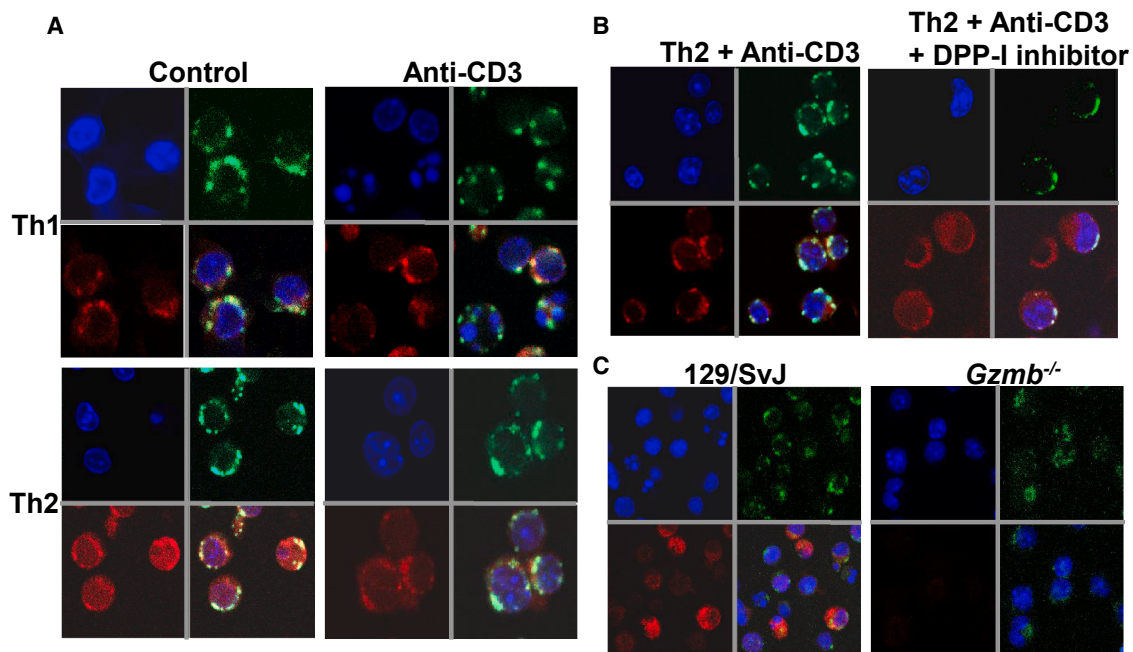


Figure 5. Differential GrB Degranulation in Th1 Cells and Th2 Cells (corrected)

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Image misplacements were identified in Figure 5. Specifically, in Figure 5A bottom (Th2) and Figure 5B, the left and right images were inadvertently placed in the wrong order during figure assembly. The corrected figure now shows the correct order. This correction does not affect the conclusions of the paper. In addition, in Figure 5A (bottom right) and Figure 5B (left) were derived from the same treatment group (Th2 + Anti-CD3), the same images were used to show the release of granzyme B from LAMP-1 granules.
